### Meet the Teacher and Parent Consultations

At the beginning of the year, you will be invited to a Meet the Teacher meeting to find out about the class routines and to ask questions. There will be further opportunities to meet with your child's class teacher at our Parent Consultation Meetings in October and February. We also have an open evening in July.
